# **Showing Up With Integrity**

## **Personal Responsibility**

We fully commit to you. We ask that you bring that same level of commitment to us.

We ask that you create space in your life by carving out time and limiting distractions as much as possible to ensure you receive the full benefits of the training.

The more you involve yourself in The Mentor Training, the more you will get out of it. We ask that you show up with integrity & take full responsibility during this course. This starts by agreeing that everything shared as part of the program - with us, between participants and with your practice clients - stays fully confidential.

We also ask you to show up on time to all your calls (live teaching calls, listening partnerships and practice sessions). To accommodate as many time zones as possible we will host two calls on the live training days - please choose one and try to attend the same session (AM or PM) every time.

#### **Ethics**

A big part of this program is based on participation: in the group chat on Telegram and in listening partnerships.

Mentoring happens as part of a relationship between you and your mentee, participating in the group is a great way to practise showing up for yourself and others

We ask that you show up with the same level of integrity and consideration as you will as a mentor. Please always be respectful to others. The community and listening partnerships are safe spaces, please do not mentor or coach each other outside of your practice sessions.

Remember that all information shared is confidential, if you need space to process something that was shared, reach out to us.

Your practice sessions should be free of charge, allow yourself to be a beginner.

Please read and sign <u>The Mentor Training Standards of Ethical Conduct, here.</u> This is due before you begin your practice sessions.
